The middle order pegs had performed well on Friday during a practice session, would it be the same today.

It proved not, it was rock hard, water level is up to the max but very clear and the fish did not want to feed at close range (except peg 3). Steve Burfoot was the man today on peg 3 catching 81lb of carp mostly on the pole line with method feeder,

Colin Rennison (right) struggled on peg 23 until the last hour when he managed to bank good carp for 24lb 8oz, Neil Anderson wasn't far behind with 20lb 8oz, mainly small carp, having lost a few to hook pulls.
