A carp in the first five minutes raised hopes but after losing another and having two smaller F1's pull off at the net his peg died until the last hour when two more carp boosted his mixed bag weight. A hook-pull, after a 10 minute tussle with a large carp in the dying, minutes probably denying him 2<sup>nd</sup> place.

Elsewhere on the main lake things were very slow with few carp or bream caught.
