Snapping on his hills was Roger Brown on the peg that won the previous match at RR – 23. His 35.02 was mostly on worm and included bream.

The Silvers Pot went to Richard Lear on 32 with a modest 12.04 of ‘non-carp’ on maggot and 2nd place silvers went to Dave Aris. The rule now is that all members of the carp family are now excluded from the silvers net.
