Winner Stan had more than half his weight with bream which rarely show down at 22, his three carp coming in the first hour of the match before the sun got on the water. This gave Stan both the main pool and the silvers top spot. Second place Ray had his carp steady through the day using either worm or maggot fished tight to the floating island. Elsewhere it was the usual stories of lost carp and a struggle to get any bites at all. Yet pleasure anglers on the other bank were catching well.
