Two weeks on from our last match here and the weights were almost identical. Once again, peg 30 is the place to be at the moment. With fewer proper carp showing the reliable crucians and brown goldfish, competing with good sized bream out in the open water, gives it the edge when conditions are right. Throw in a bonus carp, like the one of 6.12 that Dave landed, and there was no doubt about the winner.

By contrast, peg 38 has little form at this time of year. But if fish have shoaled up in the bay then, as Simon Jee found out, a good weight is possible. He had nearly 12lb of silvers backed up by a couple of carp for his 2nd place.

Third place could have gone to one of about five of the runners up. One carp, bream or even big perch can make a big difference and this time it was Alan Thomas's turn for some good fortune as he patiently fished long on peg 24 using pinkies. His 7.04 of carp was four small fish but his silvers net included a 2lb bream and a 2.09 perch in it to make 13.01 in total.



Once again chub showed, Stan having one of over 2lb plus a few 1lb+ perch and Roger had another around 12oz.

Next week it's back to Damsel Lake at Southend Farm the Riverside again, alternating each week until 12 Dec.

In the New Year we should be back at Frogmore once again, alternating with Riverside until it closes for trout fishing in late Feb when we will then elect another alternate venue.
